NTUUC Recognition Awards

Evaluation Criteria:

- † Active membership in an NTUUC congregation.
- † Contributions beyond the congregation. We look for people who have represented their congregations effectively in UUA circles, and/or locally in interfaith and partner organizations, in leadership roles such as organizer, recruiter, or spokesperson.
- † Relevant and visible contributions to the congregation and especially to the growth of UUism in North Texas. These could be short or long-term projects, and especially ones that could be replicated by other congregations.
- † Supporting material – please include specific examples:
 - a) How this contribution reflects our ideals and the growth of UUism;
 - b) How the contributor is a role model;
 - c) How this person has been active in recruiting others, including their successor(s);
 - d) How this person has taken the congregation's message out into the community, and the resulting impact, both internal and external.
